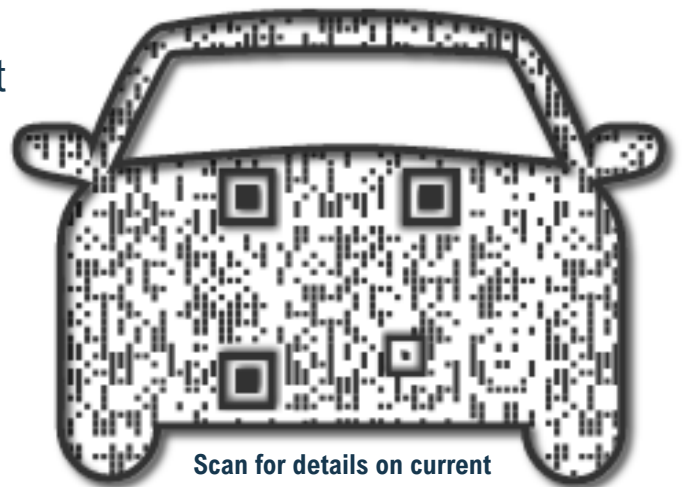

FAQ – HIRING EVENT

- When is the hiring event?
 - Saturday, May 20, 2023, from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
- Where is the hiring event?
 - Seminole County Tax Collector, Altamonte Branch
150 N. Westmonte Dr., Altamonte Springs, FL 32714.
- How should I dress for the hiring event?
 - Dress business casual.
- What should I bring for the hiring event?
 - Bring an updated copy of your resume.
 - We strongly encourage you to submit an online job application via www.SeminoleCounty.Tax/Employment prior to attending the hiring event.
 - If you are unable to complete an online job application, we will have paper applications for you to complete during the hiring event.
- What position are you hiring for at the hiring event?
 - We are hiring exclusively for Full-Time Customer Service Representatives (CSR).
- What will happen during the hiring event?
 - The hiring event will consist of three (3) phases:
 1. A presentation to familiarize you with the Seminole County Tax Collector Office, the services we provide, and the responsibilities of the Customer Service Representative (CSR) position.
 2. A pre-employment skills test to evaluate your computer skills.
 3. An interview with our hiring managers if you pass the pre-employment skills test.
- What is the starting hourly rate?
 - The initial starting hourly rate is \$16.00 hourly.



FAQ – HIRING EVENT

- Will I get an offer the same day?
 - Candidates that successfully pass the three phases will be considered for the position openings; our hiring team will reach out to candidates after the event concludes to make a job offer.

- How can I prepare for the hiring event?
 - Make sure to review the Customer Service Representative (CSR) job description posted online www.SeminoleCounty.Tax/Employment to familiarize yourself with the position responsibilities and requirements.

 - Practice your typing skills by going online and taking a free typing test.

- If I am selected for the Customer Service Representative (CSR) position, when will I start?
 - Our next new hire training class is projected to begin in Mid-June.

- If I am selected for the Customer Service Representative (CSR) position, are there any additional steps I need to take before I am able to start?
 - Yes, you will need to successfully pass a pre-employment criminal background check and drug test.

- Does the Customer Service Representative (CSR) position offer any benefits?
