Business Checklist

Before applying, if your business is in unincorporated Seminole County, you must:

- ☐ Call the Seminole County Planning and Development Division to check zoning requirements for your location at (407) 665-7371.
- ☐ Call the Seminole County Building Division to determine if a permit will be required at (407) 665-7050.
- ☐ Contact the Seminole County Fire Department to schedule a fire inspection at (407) 665-7422, email scfdinspections@seminolecountyfl.gov or complete an online request at: www.seminolecountyfl.gov

What we'll need from you:

- ☐ The completed Seminole County Business Tax Receipt application, signed by an Owner, Partner, or Officer of the Corporation or LLC.
- ☐ Federal Tax ID Number (FEIN) or Social Security Number (Required by FL Statute 205.0535-[6])
- ☐ Sunbiz.org print out of your registered business (Corporation, LLC, LTD or Fictitious Name) if your business name is anything other than your legal first and last name.
- ☐ Proof of residency (if setting up business at a residential location in unincorporated Seminole County)
- ☐ Proof of licensure (if regulated profession)
- ☐ Copy of City Business Tax Receipt (if business is within city limits of Lake Mary, Winter Springs, Casselberry or Sanford)
- ☐ Bill of Sale and current year/original Seminole County Business Tax Receipt (required for the transfer of ownership of an existing business).
